Kirchner Museum



The Kirchner Museum Davos offers the visitor the extraordinary chance to look at works of the expressionist Ernst Ludwig Kirchner in the same place they were created. Davos and its environment were the artist's inspiration for a large number of important pictures. In 1992, the Kirchner Foundation was able to acquire a large collection of the artist's work, since then, the collection has been enlarged considerably. The collection includes over 1,400 drawings, graphic works, textiles and paintings, sculptures and sketchbooks. In addition the collection contains over 800 photographs, documents and an important library devoted to both Kirchner and Expressionism. A guided tour gives you an insight into these major works of art as you step into their world for a few memorable moments.

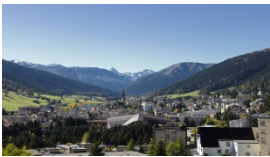

Adventure Park Färich
